The 12th International Basement Tectonics Conference was hosted by the School of Geology and Geophysics and the Oklahoma Geological Survey in the Sarkeys Energy Center on the campus of the University of Oklahoma, Norman, Oklahoma, U. S. A., from May 21st through May 26th, 1995. A total of 52 individuals were in attendance, 9 of which were attending from 6 different foreign countries. Four days of oral and poster presentations were divided into four technical sessions with the following themes: 1) Fracture Development, Reactivation, and Mineralization, organized by M. I. Bartholomew and S. Marshak; 2) Evolution of the Basement of the North American Plate (with special emphasis on its southern margin), organized by R. E. Denison and E. G. Lidiak; 3) Probing of Basement: Geophysical and Geochemical Methods, organized by R. A. Young and G. R. Keller; and 4) Response of Cover Rocks to Basement Deformation, organized by P. Berendsen and M. P. Carlson. Seventy-five presentations were made during the course of the meeting, which was organized by Program Chairman M. Charles Gilbert and professionally managed by Sara Moody. Preceding the meeting was a two-day field trip to examine the mode and kinematics of tectonic accretion during closure of an ocean basin, as preserved in the Precambrian geology of the eastern Iano
