

Before starting upon the narrative of the events which finallybrought about the extinction of the nation which here occupies our attention, let us cast a glance upon the former historic facts in order to compass the extent of territory occupied by this people when still in its native, flourishing condition. HABITAT OF THE NATION. A promontory of the mainland in the West bay, fifteen miles southwest of Galveston city, Galveston county, is called Caronkaway point to this day. This was one of their fishing and stopping stations and also formed one end of the shallow ford which allowed them to cross over to the sand bar opposite in good weather. By this ford a party of theirs escaped at night when attacked by Lafitte s men in 1818. This point is the easternmost place in their possession which I have been able to discover. It explains their vicinity to the Atakapa tribe and the adoption of that language by a part of the Karankawa nation (as referred to by Dr. Sibley), who continued speaking their own language besides. The extensive shores of the neighboring Galveston bay were probably visited by them also, and Morse (1822) heard of some living upon San Jacinto river. We know that west of these the Karankawas held or claimed both sides of the mouth of Colorado river, Texas, and the map...
