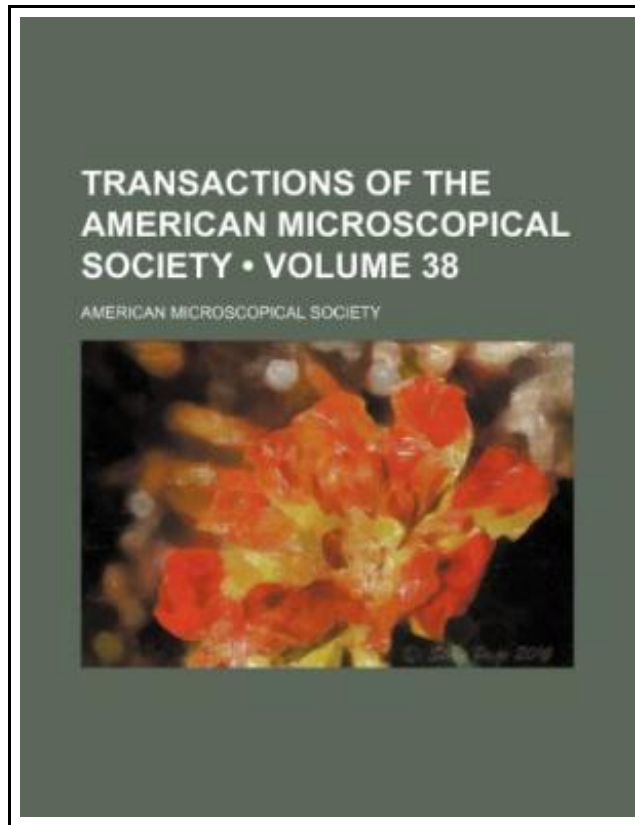

INTRODUCTION It is as lamentable as interesting that a group of animals presenting so many unusual and important objects of investigation as do the nematodes, should have received so little attention from a general morphological point of view, despite the fact that they have been studied from so many other angles. It is for this reason that systematic studies upon the Nematoda have been so unsatisfactory in the past. With the hope that a very detailed study of the morphology of this group will throw some light on the present chaotic situation, the author has undertaken the study of a single species to find out its precise structure. This work has been done with the hope that it will not only contribute definite information on certain features of anatomy heretofore altogether unknown or at best little described, but will furnish a stimulus to others for investigation along morphological lines in the Nematoda. If as many forms are accurately described among this group as have been in other parasitic classes, there can be no doubt that this difficult branch will be as easily handled systematically as any other. This work has been done under the direction and with the criticism of Professor Henry Baldwin Ward. To him I express my earnest Contributions from the Zoological Laboratory...
